

COVID-19 Tests – A Rapidly Evolving Market

- Currently 22 FDA approved tests under Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)
- Most tests take several days to a week for results
- Recently, several rapid diagnostic tests approved under EUA that deliver results in 5-15 minutes







Beware of Fraudulent Coronavirus Tests, Vaccines and Treatments





COVID related domain registration ramping up

In March 2020:

- At least 100,000 new domain names were registered
 - o Terms like "covid," "corona," and "virus"
 - O More domains registered to sell items such as medical masks. 22
 - Domains were used to spam out advertisements for COVID-themed scams.
- Phishing....The number of confirmed malicious COVID-related domains is in the thousands.
- New domain names fitting the phishing profile are being registered at the rate of around 1,000 per day.

Protect your pharmacy and patients

- ✓ Be informed -- Fact check
 - Is the product FDA approved or cleared or under an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA)
 - ☐ For drugs check: https://www.accessdata.fda.gov/scripts/cder/daf/index.cfm
 - ☐ For biologics check: https://www.fda.gov/vaccines-blood-biologics/biologics-products-establishments
 - For devices check: https://www.fda.gov/medical-devices/products-and-medical-procedures/device-approvals-denials-and-clearances
 - For EUAs: https://www.fda.gov/emergency-preparedness-and-response/mcm-legal-regulatory-and-policy-framework/emergency-use-authorization#2019-ncov
 - Is the product on the drug shortage list?
 - ☐ Check: https://www.accessdata.fda.gov/scripts/drugshortages/default.cfm
- ✓ Know your source
 - Only buy from trusted sources. Do your due diligence.
- ✓ Protect patient information
- ✓ Practice smart online safety
- ✓ Report suspected fraud to FDA, FTC, FCC (check their websites for reporting portals)



Advocating for You on Coronavirus



In the past week....

- Pharmacist Safety: APhA requested OSHA to clarify protections for pharmacists and pharmacy staff as front-line providers of patient care. New OSHA COVID-19 Guide: . https://www.osha.gov/Publications/OSHA3990.pdf
- **Compounding**: APhA sent joint comments to FDA urging flexibility to allow pharmacists to compound products that are at risk of shortage and flexibility for the temporary compounding of alcohol-based sanitizer guidance in light of ingredient shortages
- Inappropriate Prescribing: APhA issued statements, alone and jointly with AMA and ASHP, on inappropriate prescribing and dispensing of COVID-19 off-label medications
