VOTER REGISTRATION FORMS

Digital vs Paper

Most states allow for digital registration except for Arkansas, Maine, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, New Jersey, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Dakota, Texas, and Wyoming. Paper federal registration forms can be aquired only at the U.S. Election Assistance Commission at https://www.eac.gov/voters/national-mail-voter-registration-form. This form includes information for state registration as well! Federal registration forms are not allowed in Wymoming, New Hamshipre and North Dakota

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Earliest is 28-30 days before election

These states include: Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, Ohio, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas KNOW YOUR REGISTRATION DEADLINES
