Date: Effective Immediately

Registration for the APhA Meeting the Requirements for Accreditation of a PGY1 Community Pharmacy Residency Program- A Skills Workshop is conducted by registering for a specific program date and location (city/state). Once an individual is registered for a specific program (date and location), APhA will no longer accommodate transfers into another program because of a user error, unforeseen date conflict, travel issues, illness or other mishaps that disallow for seminar attendance by the individual.

Please ensure you are registering for the correct date and location prior to purchasing the activity. Due to the significantly reduced rate, no refunds are issued for the programs. If you have registered for an incorrect date or location, registration in the correct program will be required at an additional \$325 member or \$575 nonmember fee. If registration is at capacity for that program, you will be added to the wait list and contacted if a space becomes available.
